National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH) values the continuing support and commitment of all our assessors and partner stakeholders.

The Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak is a rapidly evolving situation and NABH is striving 24/7 to analyse, coordinate with hospitals and assessors and all partners to manage our work as related with accreditations, certifications, inspections and training.

1. As part of strategic preparedness and response plan it is further decided to extend the validity period of accreditation cycle by three months or till situation normalises, whichever is earlier. This will be applicable on all accredited hospitals who have already applied for re accreditation as on date. This is also applicable to all other accreditation and certification programs.
2. In all accreditation programs, the new applicants on and from 1st April 2020 will be given choice to opt for **or** skip the pre-assessment. This is as per board approved policy.
