

NABH Assessor Training Program for Dental Accreditation Programme

NABH proposes to conduct a four days Dental Assessor Course at following cities:

Delhi from August 01-04, 2019

Mumbai from September 05-08, 2019

Bangalore from October 03-06, 2019

Course details and fee: The course is non-residential and the participant has to attend all the four days. The course involves the interactive teaching & group exercises. The evaluation of the participants will be based on the daily monitoring of performance, practical and written examination. The successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors. The fee for the training course is Rs. **20,000/- + 18% tax** which also includes lunch & tea for 4 days. Payment to be made by demand draft in favor of 'Quality Council of India' payable at New Delhi.

Eligibility Criteria for applying for NABH Dental Assessors Training Program:

Essential criteria:

MDS with 10 years of experience/ BDS with 12 years of experience. Out of above experience, at least 5 years of clinical experience in a dental healthcare facility.

Experience in quality improvement activity, administration, accreditation, certification would be desirable

Experience of at least one year in implementation of NABH accreditation standards in their organization. Candidate with higher experience than the minimum will be preferred.

Only short listed candidates shall be informed and ask to deposit the course fee.
