

NABH MIS Assessor Training Program **(For Assessments of Medical Imaging Centres)**

MIS Standards, are meant for the standalone Medical Imaging centres / Medical Imaging organizations, which have a desire to implement quality system to improve quality and patient safety. These standards can be used by the organization to enter the realm of systematic quality management across a healthcare organization.

The standards cover the vitals of quality and safety management, and would facilitate in delivering high quality care.

NABH proposes to have a three days MIS Assessor Training Program covering 2nd edition MIS Accreditation Standards, at Chennai & Delhi from 7th to 9th February 2020 & 21st to 23rd February 2020 respectively.

Course details and fee: The course is non-residential and the participant has to attend on all the three days. The course involves the interactive teaching and exercises. The evaluation of the participants will be based on the daily monitoring of performance and practical and written examination. The successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors. The fee for the training course is Rs. 15,000/- + 18% tax which includes lunch & tea for 3 days. The copy of NABH MIS standard - 2nd edition and the course study material will be provided as a part of the course.

Eligibility Criteria for applying for NABH Assessors Course:

- **For Radiologists:**

Degree in Medicine (M.B.B.S) with post graduate Degree in Radiology (M.D.R.D/ D.N.B) with minimum 10 year Clinical experience in the respective field.

OR

Degree in Medicine (M.B.B.S) with Diploma in Radiology (D.M.R.D) with minimum 12 years experience in the respective field

- **For Nuclear Medicine Physician:**

Degree in Medicine (M.B.B.S) with post graduate Degree in Nuclear Medicine (M.D.R.M) with minimum 10 year Clinical experience in the respective field.

OR

Degree in Medicine (M.B.B.S) with Diploma in Nuclear Medicine (D.N.B/D.R.M) with minimum 12 years experience in the respective field

Desirable criteria for all categories will be either successful completion of Program on Implementation for Hospital Accreditation or experience of at least one year of implementation of NABH MIS accreditation standards.

Candidate with higher qualification and/or experience over as stated by minimum will be preferred. Participants should be proficient with the requirements of the NABH standards and interpretation.

Note: Only shortlisted candidates will be informed by email and asked to submit scanned copy of Biographies, Degrees Certificates (Graduation and Post-Graduation) along with experience Certificate and applicable Fee.
