

NABH Assessor Training Program
(For Assessments of Healthcare Organizations)

NABH proposes to conduct a five days assessor training program for Ophthalmologists only. The course will cover Hospital, SHCO and ECO Accreditation as well as Entry Level certification. Course will be conducted at Bangalore, Karnataka from 12^h to 16th June 2019.

Course details and fee: The course is non-residential and the participant has to attend on all the five days. The course involves the interactive teaching & exercises. The evaluation of the participants will be based on the daily monitoring of performance and Practical and written examination. The successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors. The fee for the training course is Rs. 25,000/- + 18% tax which also includes lunch & tea for 5 days. The standard booklets for various programs at NABH will be couriered to you before the program. You are required to pay Rs. 10,000/- (No GST on this amount) at the time of sending the fee. All payments to be made by separate Demand Drafts in favour of 'Quality Council of India' payable at New Delhi.

Eligibility Criteria for applying for NABH Assessors Course:

For Ophthalmologists:	MBBS with MS Ophthalmology with 10 years of experience of which 5 years should be in a hospital. Higher qualification in clinical branches will be preferable.
Desirable criteria	Experience of at least one year in implementation of Hospital/SHCO or NABH accreditation standards in their organization. Candidate with higher experience than minimum will be preferred. Additional Quality Management Certifications are desirable. Candidates having successful completion of POI conducted by NABH on NABH Accreditation standards or entry level standards are desirable. Participants should be proficient with the requirements of the NABH standards and the interpretation.

Only short listed candidates shall be asked to deposit the course fee.
