

**NABH Assessor Training Course**  
(Pre-accreditation entry level hospital and small healthcare certification programme)

NABH proposed to have three days assessor training programme at **New Delhi** during **October 3 to October 5, 2016**.

**Course details and fee:** The course is non-residential and participant has to attend all the three days. The course involves the interactive teaching & exercises. The evaluation of the participants will be based on the daily monitoring of performance and a written examination. The successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors for Pre-accreditation entry level hospital and small healthcare certification programme. The fee for the training course is **Rs. 15,000/-** which include the course material, lunch & tea for three days. The fee for nursing candidate is subsidized and is **Rs. 12,000/-** only. The fee is to be paid by DD in favour of '**Quality Council of India**' payable at **New Delhi**.

<b>For Administrator</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Post-graduate in healthcare management/ administration (Degree or Diploma) or equivalent with minimum of 8 years of experience (post PG) of which a minimum of 3 years should be in healthcare management/ administration.</li> </ul>
<b>For Nursing Assessor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• GNM with minimum of 12 years of experience of which a minimum of 8 years should be in hospital.</li> <li>• BSc (Nursing) with minimum of 10 years of experience of which a minimum of 5 years should be in a hospital/ academic setting.</li> <li>• MSc (Nursing) with minimum of 8 years of experience (post PG) of which a minimum of 3 years should be in a hospital/ academic setting</li> </ul>

- Attendance at three day NABH program on Implementation course
