

Transition plan for Safe-I certified and applicant Hospitals

Sr. No.	Status of Hospitals w.r.t. Safe I	Action Plan
1.	Hospitals where handholding is going on	Hospitals will be given option to continue with handholding activities and finish it within 4 months. If they do not wish to continue, then there will be no refund of application fees.
2.	New Applicant Hospitals where handholding has not been started	Full refund of fees will be processed within 45 days starting from 1 st February 2018.
3.	Applicant Hospitals which are certified for first time	Validity of the certificate will be only for 1 year from the date of certification.
4.	Certified hospitals where surveillance assessment is due.	Surveillance Assessment will not be done as certificate will be valid now only for 1 year from the date of certification and after which the validity of the certificate will expire. In addition, no fees for the next year/cycle will be accepted.

5.	Certified Hospital where renewal certification is in process.	Validity of the certificate will be only for 1 year from the date of renewal of certification after which the validity of the certificate will expire. If they do not wish to continue then there will be no refund of fees.
6.	Certified hospitals where renewal is due.	Renewal of certification will not be done.
7.	Hospitals where certificate issued with 2 years validity.	Since surveillance assessment will not be conducted and 2 nd year certification fees will not be accepted, validity of the certificate will expire after 1 year from the date of certification.
8.	Applicant hospitals, which are in hand-holding phase (which have paid) and have not responded to previous communications.	Hospital will be issued a warning letter to complete their handholding activities in 4 months' time. In case of non-response from them within 10 days from the date of this notice, applications will be closed. Therefore, no refund of fees will be given to the organization.
9.	Application closed	The hospitals that have already been informed of the closures. There will not be any refund of fees.
