NABH announces three-days Hospital Assessors' Training Program for NABH Stroke Care Certification Standards, 1st Edition

Date: 13th, 14th & 15th December 2023

Place: New Delhi

Course details and fee: The 3 days course shall be conducted in onsite mode and the participant has to attend on all the three days. The training course involves interactive teaching & exercises. There would be an evaluation of the participants which includes daily monitoring of performance and a written examination on the last day. Only the successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors. The fee for the training course is 15,000 + GST @ 18% (includes the cost of NABH standard and study material).

Note: Only shortlisted participants (as intimated) would be required to pay the fee online through pay now option available under "Training & Education" Tab.

Eligibility Criteria for applying for this Assessor Course:

Essential Criteria

For Clinicians:	Post-graduation in the clinical subject (MD/ DNB Medicine with experience in stroke management) with minimum of 7 years of total experience. Higher qualification of DNB Neurology/ DM Neurology will be preferred.
For Nursing:	B. Sc. Nursing with at least two years of clinical experience in stroke management with minimum of 10 years of overall experience. Higher qualification will be preferred.

Desirable Criteria (for all Categories)

- At least 5 years of experience in a NABH Accredited/Certified Hospital
- Attended POI on NABH Hospital Standards
- Implementation of NABH Accreditation Standards in their respective Organization
- Higher Qualification and experience will be preferred

Note:

- The above criteria may be supplemented with additional qualification(s), experience and skill(s) as per NABH requirements.
- Mere eligibility and applying for Assessor Course do not guarantee selection.
- NABH reserves the rights of selecting participants as per its operational requirements eg. give preference to the candidate from underserved and remote areas. It is sole NABH Secretariat's discretion to select or reject the candidate as per the operational requirements of NABH.
- The participants who could not qualify the post training examination in the previous courses may reapply.
- NABH may conduct interview of the candidates before final selection.
